

Work Zone Safety Issues

- Road traffic crashes kill 1.2 M people annually
- Specific safety issues in work zones unclear
 - ARROWS: "increase in accident risk vary from a few to several hundred percent"
- Adequate transportation is vital to all economies





Work Zone Safety Solutions: Many Roles

- Politicians: take an active interest in road safety
- Road authorities: develop and use safety standards
- Designers: consider safety issues in roadway plans



Work Zone Safety Solutions: Many Roles



- Contractors: train personnel adequately
- Workers: actively follow safety procedures
- Drivers: behave responsibly
- Police: actively participate



Principles of Safe Work Zone Management

- Conspicuous Is the approaching work zone obvious, noticeable and eye-catching?
- Clear Does the driver know what to do? How fast?
 What lane? Are the signs and lane markings correct?
 Does the driver have all the necessary information?
- **Consistent** Does the work zone look and feel like others the driver has encountered in the past?
- Credible Does the driver receive any conflicting information? Does the driver believe that speed reductions are necessary?



- Minimize delay to road users
- Provide clear and positive guidance

 - Delineation markings, land separators, cones and posts,














Personnel Issues

Basic Work Zone Layout




Lead in Taper

- Speed determines length
- Safety zone keep clear of machinery and vehicles
- Cones, posts or positive separation
- Works area
 - Maintain safe distance from vehicles
- Exit Taper
 - Drivers resume normal operations
